THE ECONOMIC IMPACT OF REMOTE BANKRUPTCY VENUE ON THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

When a business facing financial difficulty files a Chapter 11 bankruptcy case, the location of the bankruptcy case can have tremendous impact on the local economy. This is because the survival and reorganization of the distressed company will impact local jobs and wages for years to come. Trade creditors, employees and retirees' ability to participate in the bankruptcy case is curtailed when the venue of the case is located thousands of miles away in a remote court.

When a company stays home to reorganize, local parties can participate and the local economy retains the immediate and long-term economic benefits of the case remaining in the debtor's headquarter city. Hotels, restaurants, transportation and business services benefit from the bankruptcy case as attorneys and restructuring professionals attend hearings and meetings both in and outside the courthouse. Thus, the presence of a large Chapter 11 bankruptcy case can generate significant revenues, taxes and jobs for the local economy. These economic benefits are diverted from the local economy when a company flees to a faraway jurisdiction to file bankruptcy.

The current bankruptcy law allows a company to file bankruptcy in locations outside its "home base," i.e., where it is headquartered or where its products and services are primarily produced. Many businesses are incorporated in the State of Delaware, even though those businesses generally have no headquarters, employees or operations in Delaware. Similarly, many business have an office located in New York City in the Southern Judicial District of New York, even though their principal operations, assets and employees are located elsewhere. Under the current law, 860 Chapter 11 bankruptcy cases - 735 in Delaware and 125 in the Southern District of New York - were filed in distant bankruptcy courts from 2004 through 2016, instead of the cities where these companies operate and employ thousands of people.

These 860 remote bankruptcy filings mean that judges in faraway cities decide the fate of hundreds of companies located in other states. This distance inherently limited the input from the home base by those businesses and individuals most directly impacted by the bankruptcy, such as employees, retirees and trade creditors.

In addition, local economies lost significant revenue by not having the bankruptcy cases administered in their local bankruptcy courts. In contrast, the economies of Delaware and the Southern District of New York benefitted by the amount of approximately \$300 million per year



from legal fees and other spending from these non-local bankruptcy cases.¹ Based on the number of cases for the 13 year period reviewed, each state lost approximately \$4.54 million in revenue per case.

With respect to California, the statistics are staggering. According to the Commercial Law League of America's research, of the 860 bankruptcy cases filed Delaware and New York, California was the home state of 118 cases.² These cases involved assets totally approximately \$56 billion and debts totaling approximately \$66 billion. The cases impacted approximately 152,000 employees and 960,000 creditors – along with the various people who live near and do business with these companies. In terms of economic impact, the California economy suffered approximately **\$536 million** in lost revenue from these local cases being filed non-locally.

If the bankruptcy venue law was changed to eliminate the ability of a company to file bankruptcy outside of its home state, California companies would reorganize in California before California courts. Not only would this restore local control of local cases, the associated revenue, tax base and jobs connected with administering the bankruptcy cases would "stay home". We believe this change to the law would produce a fairer outcome for all the parties involved.
